「キャンベラに居住する女性のパーソナル・ネットワーク調査」 の基礎分析(その3)

筆者は2013年3月から5月にかけてキャンベラにおいて女性のパーソナル・ネットワークと集団加入に関する調査を実施した。本稿の目的は、調査票にあるそれぞれの質問への回答結果を提示し、考察を加えることである。集計結果を検討し、次の3点を明らかにした。①約半数の回答者はキャンベラで10代をおくっていた。②回答者は民族的出自でイギリス系やオーストラリア系が多い。③回答者とその夫ないしパートナーは社会経済的地位が高い。本稿は、既に掲載している「『キャンベラに居住する女性のパーソナル・ネットワーク調査』の基礎分析(その1)」(野邊 2015)と「同(その2)」(野邊 2016)に続くものである。本稿で扱っているQ35~Q42の回答結果の分析・検討については、前者を参照されたい。
